Call to Order – The meeting was called to order by Project Director Camille Castillo at 9:04 a.m.

Welcome and Introductions – Camille welcomed the members and thanked Centro San Vicente for hosting. Yovanni Atienzo, Case Manager Supervisor, gave an overview of its programs and services. Members in attendance from various agencies introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes – A motion for approval of the EPCH General Membership Meeting minutes from January 9, 2020 was made by Lucino Martinez and seconded by Shadecie Walker. All approved.

Coc Board Report – Due to no CoC Board member being in attendance, this item was not addressed.

Planning Report – Shadecie Walker, Planning Committee chair, discussed the issues brought up at the planning committee such as data quality; CoC, ESG, and HHSP definitions which Camille will send out based on the recommendation from Shadecie; and prioritizing youth for the upcoming ESG TDHCA competition. Planning Committee meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 9:00 a.m. at TRLA.

Coordinated Entry System – Camille Castillo, Project Director for the Coalition and interim chair for the Coordinated Assessment Oversight Committee, facilitated the monthly conversation regarding the local Coordinated Entry system. Lucino Martinez provided a breakdown of how many assessments and referrals were completed for the month of January 2020.

Critical Time Intervention Strategy – Margie Villasenor, Case Manager at Project VIDA, discussed the three phases of an intensive case management approach that is designed to reduce the risk of recurrent homelessness among individuals who are transitioning from shelters to permanent houses. The three phases of CTI are: transition, try-out, and transfer of care.
