Homeless parents differ from single adults experiencing homelessness in several respects....

- Tend to be younger (Average age = 31.4 vs. 45.4 years)
- Less likely to have experienced domestic violence (6.9% vs. 10.8%)
- More likely to have experienced first time homelessness (56.9% vs. 29.6%)
- Less likely to be veterans (0.0% vs. 10.3%)
- Less likely to report having problems with alcohol or substance abuse (1.7% vs. 19.2%)
- Less likely to have a felony (3.4% vs. 17.2%)
